Callan Park Gallery will host a solo exhibition of drawings by German artist, Michael Hall, during September and October 2012. Showing in Australia for the first time, this is a special opportunity to be able to say you were among the first to see this internationally significant artist's work in an exhibition curated by Colin Rhodes.

An artist at the Kraichgauer Kunstwerkstatt workshop in Sinsheim, Germany, Hall is most well known for his colourful drawings, although he also occasionally makes sculptures. His true passion is for drawing and he often draws characters not to scale or realistic proportions, using different image planes and angles in the same drawing. Hall describes himself as a joker and he enjoys depicting small jokes in his drawings. Sometimes his drawings are influenced by his love of old music and the lyrics and stories that he learns by heart, but his work is mostly influenced by his personal experiences and humorous stories.

The exhibition will be on display from Wednesday 26 September to Wednesday 17 October.
